Daily price: \$60/night

Holiday rates (\$75/night) in effect on the following seasons including but not limited to: Spring break week, Easter, 4th of July, Thanksgiving (Wednesday to Sunday), Christmas to New Year (12/23 to 1/1) and other holidays (Veterans, Labor, Presidents, etc.). Rates apply on weekend holidays from Fridays to Sundays.



Boarding is by reservation and requires a \$100 non-refundable deposit, \$150 for holidays. Cancellations with a 48 hour notice will receive credit, except for holidays, for which we'd need one full week notice. Cancellations notice with less than 48 hours or one week during holidays will result in loss of deposit.

Drop off/Pick up times 10:00-13:00 or 14:00-17:00

If you are unable to receive/pick up your dog in our 10:00-13:00 window, a daycare fee of \$30 will apply when your dog is dropped off/picked up in our 14:00-17:00 time slot. If you pick up or ask for a drop off after 17:00, a full day boarding fee will apply.

****Pick up and drop off services available by request: times may vary. Basic fee: \$35 each way on weekdays and \$45 on weekends, \$50 on holidays (within 10 miles from our location in Yorba Linda), plus \$1 per mile each way if in excess of 10 miles. If pick up/drop off times are different from our specified hours on weekdays, please add \$10 per each.****

Items to bring to camp: Your dog's regular diet and a printed, filled out and signed copy of the boarding agreement, plus a copy of current vaccination records. No beds or bowls please! Send toys only if playtime/walks are requested. No large chewing items either please!

If your dog's food needs: Preparation, cooking, freezing or refrigerating, extra fees may apply according to the time involved in the process and the space needed in the fridge.

_____ It is not uncommon for some dogs to feel stressed out when first settling into a new environment. However, if your dog needs extra safety precautions and one-on-one time due to fear, aggression, or anxiety to keep our staff and your dog safe, there will be a \$100 a day training/special handling fee to help your dog acclimate. We will notify you if your dog needs special handling. Once your dog is able to be safely handled by our staff, you will be notified and the fee will end.

_____ Some dogs with stress/anxiety/fear issues (being treated or not) or picky eaters, won't eat their regular meals in its entirety or skip some of them. Hereby you expressly authorize us, to take any necessary provisions/measures to guarantee your dog eats well. This could mean a partial or total change and/or additions to his/her regular food, for the food or combination of foods that he/she would eat, always taking care of your dog's preferences, known allergies and health issues. This will have an extra daily cost of \$25.

_____ Although we separate our play groups based on age, size, and temperament, dog play is not without risk. Owners are financially responsible for all damage that may occur to another dog, person and/or property.

_____ If your dog becomes ill while in our care, we will immediately seek veterinary help. Owners are financially responsible for all veterinary bills. If we cannot reach you during an emergency, I authorize Pro K9 Ops to spend up to \$_____ to treat my dog. There is a \$75 fee if we need to take your dog to the vet.

_____ We take pride in the cleanliness of our facility and follow protocols to ensure we are cleaning to the highest standard. Although we take these extreme precautions dogs may be exposed to a variety of organisms. Owners assume risk and are financially responsible for any veterinary bills.

*Please Note: Our veterinarian has recommended the Bordetella vaccine. It does go around periodically and because it has a long incubation period, it spreads quickly in places where dogs interact. It is impossible to prevent, unless every dog is quarantined for two weeks before boarding. If your dog begins to show coughing symptoms, we will inform you immediately. If a dog shows any signs, we will immediately separate them, let the owner know, and either send them home or quarantine them if the owner cannot pick them up. The vet recommends starting antibiotics if the dogs begin coughing to treat any secondary infections.
